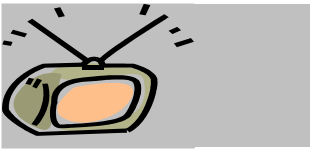

While to most of us this may seem a long time away presentation nights for the children have been booked and details are as follows:

### ROOBALL

Presentation on Saturday 15th September, 2007 from 12pm.... we will be having a sausage sizzle, hamburgers and soft drinks for the children. Price is \$10.00 per family and payment will be made on the day although we would ask Team Managers to get a rough idea of numbers for catering purposes.

### JUNIOR TEAM

Presentations for the juniors will be held at the Dorset Gardens Hotel on Saturday 6th October, 2007, times are as follows:

#### **Ages 11, 12, 13 and 14...**

3.30pm - 6.30pm it is a buffet style all you can eat meal and the cost is \$27.00 per adult and \$15.00 per child up to the age of 18

#### **Ages 15, 16, 15G, 18G and 18**

From 7.30pm - 10.30pm again the same prices apply.

If you have children that are in both under 11 - under 14's and under 15 - Under 18's then you will only need to pay the cost once i.e. \$27.00 per adult and \$15.00 per child.

If you have any questions please ask your team manager or committee members. Payments can be made as soon as you like, however you must have payment made 10 days before this date. They will not allow any payments after this date so if you haven't paid by Tuesday 25th September sadly you will be unable to attend.

### EQUIPMENT ROOM:

Can all coaches/team managers please ensure that balls, nets, slalom poles, cones etc... Are stored in designated areas after each training session and matches rather than leaving them on the floor or on the pitch.

### DIRTY BOOTS:
