### **VOLUNTEER CANTEEN MANAGER/SUPERVISOR/ORGANISER REQUIRED**

We need a parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle or older sibling to take over the duties of running/managing our canteen from the start of November (after our current canteen manager retires to have her baby). From beginning November until the start of the 2008 season (March) this will only involve Saturday morning Goalkick sessions from 9.00 - 10.15am.

When the season starts (March 2008) this will involve ordering of canteen supplies, opening up for training nights, and Saturday morning and Sundays (for matches). Whilst it would be great to find someone that can commit to every weekend and training nights, we are aware this may be difficult to accommodate – therefore we can continue to open the canteen on training nights with volunteer parents, pay juniors (15 years or older) to run the canteen on Saturday mornings, and rostering parents on both Saturdays and Sundays for matches.

If you can't commit to managing the canteen, but can commit to a training night, or are happy to go on a roster, please also let us know.

A Food Handling Certificate is required for the Manager's position (the club can arrange for you to attend a course and subsidise the cost).
